

HAZ WASTE GENERATOR REFRESHER (On-line)

OBJECTIVE

Provide annual hazardous waste training to generators. This program is developed for generators located in the State of California required under CCR Title 22, Section 66265.16 (c). The on-line course allows flexibility for students that find it hard to attend a scheduled course or would like the flexibility of completing the refresher at their own pace.

AUDIENCE

Participating students to be selected by client. Students must be computer literate to navigate through the on-line course.

DURATION

A password and instructions are emailed to each student within 24 hours after registering for this course. The course materials must be completed within 30 days after which the account will become deactivated. This course is self paced as the student advances through the modules on their own.

FACILITIES

Students must have access to an email address and internet access at the facility where they wish to complete the on-line course.

FORMAT

This course enables you to receive the same quality instruction of NES' traditional Hazardous Waste Generator Refresher training from the comfort of your own home or office, giving you the flexibility to pick and choose when you want to complete the coursework required to renew your Hazardous Waste Generator certification. The course consists of all topics covered in the standard, classroom-based hazardous waste generator refresher training, including record keeping and management, tiered permitting, container and tank management requirements, and much more! This course meets both federal and state annual refresher requirements for trained facility personnel. The class is updated annually, reviewing fundamental practices and updating students on new regulatory requirements. This course is made up of a series of training modules that the students reads through then each module is completed by taking the module exam. Minimum passing scores are required for completion of this course.

Training program documentation provided by NES to include a certification of completion.

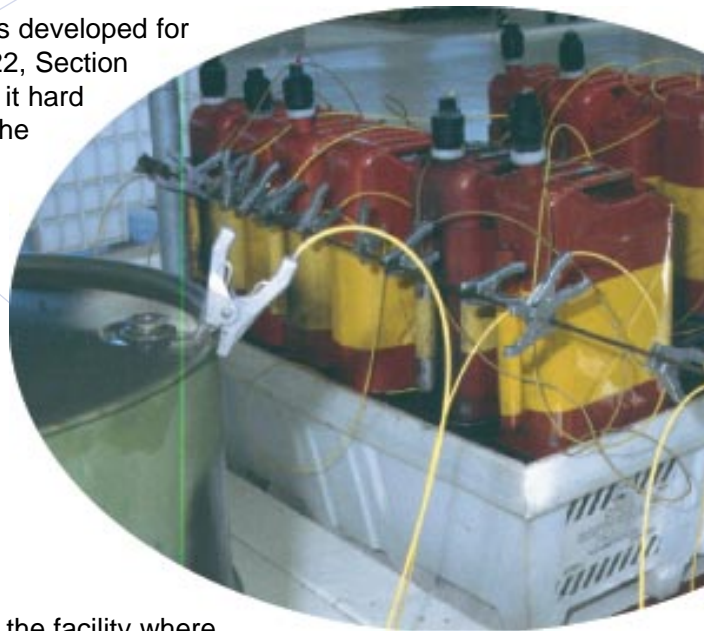
LIMITATIONS
