

2019 HAZWOPER Courses

Our HAZWOPER courses prepare students to perform hazardous waste operations safely and in compliance with OSHA regulations. HAZWOPER training is required for TSDF workers and employees engaged in remediation work in areas previously determined to be contaminated with one or more hazardous substances. These courses comply with 29 CFR 1910.120 and 8 CCR 5192 training requirements.

HAZWOPER Management & Supervisor (8-Hour) – \$299

Required for individuals who supervise or manage hazardous waste site workers and operations, this course satisfies the specialized training that is required by 29 CFR 1910.120(e)(4) and 8 CCR 5192(e)(4). Depending on site conditions, participants must previously have completed either 40-Hour HAZWOPER or 24-Hour HAZWOPER training. **(June 18 – Folsom)**

40-Hour HAZWOPER – \$699

This course is required for individuals involved in hazardous waste operations where the potential for exposure to regulated hazards exists.

24-Hour HAZWOPER – \$499

This course is required for occasional wastesite workers working at fully characterized and monitored sites where exposure above established thresholds is not expected and air monitoring or use of respirators is not required.

16-Hour HAZWOPER Supplemental – \$399

When job duties change for an employee who has completed the 24-Hour HAZWOPER, this course can be taken to meet 40-Hour HAZWOPER requirements.

8-Hour HAZWOPER & Emergency Response Refresher – \$199 Also available online for \$99

Updated yearly, topics include the latest in regulatory changes, protective clothing trends, expanded chemical hazards, emergency response procedures, field safety, respiratory protection, and revised hazard assessment techniques. *The in-class course now satisfies emergency response refresher requirements.*

Hazardous Materials Technician (24-Hour) – \$599

This 24-hour course is for workers under 29 CFR 1910.120(q) and 8 CCR 5192(q) who respond to and stop chemical releases at their facility. Training covers planning and executing emergency response operations, initial incident procedures, incident safety, scene assessment, response hazards, principles of personal safety, and response agencies. Students will receive a course manual, Emergency Response Guidebook, and certificate of completion.

First Responder Operations (8-Hour) – \$299

This 8-hour course focuses on defensive techniques used to contain and control a chemical release. The course meets 29 CFR 1910.120(q) and 8 CCR 5192(q) training requirements for first responders at the Operations level who are expected to provide defensive measures in the case of a release. Participants will receive course handouts, an Emergency Response Guidebook, and a certificate of completion.

Incident Commander (8-Hour) – \$299

This training is designed for employees who will assume control of an incident scene, beyond the first responder awareness level, for the purpose of commanding the operation. Training is intended to complement an employee's Hazardous Materials Technician competency under 29 CFR 1910.120(q) and 8 CCR 5192(q) training requirements.

Marijuana Grow Hazards Safety Training for Regulators (16-Hour) – \$499

California has legalized marijuana for recreational use, and regulatory agencies must now train personnel on the hazards commonly found at cultivation and extraction operations. This 16-hour course covers the many hazards that regulatory agency personnel may encounter when working in and around indoor/outdoor marijuana operations.

2019 Transportation Courses

Our transportation courses provide students the opportunity to learn about the safe preparation, handling, and shipping of hazardous waste and hazardous materials including the preparation and signing of the Uniform Hazardous Waste Manifest (manifest). These courses satisfy training requirements for employees who perform various transportation and/or shipping functions as part of their job duties and include course manuals, records of training, certificates of completion, and other applicable training materials.

IATA Dangerous Goods (8-Hour) – \$299

This 8-hour program satisfies the initial and recurrent (2-year) training requirements mandated by IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations applicable to ground handling agencies, freight forwarders, shippers of dangerous goods by air, and agencies engaged in security screening.

DOT Hazmat Employee (8-Hour) – \$299

This course is intended for employees who affect the safe transportation of hazardous materials and hazardous waste including those who prepare and sign Uniform Hazardous Waste Manifests. The course also serves as the three-year refresher for those who have previously taken initial training.

2019 Hazardous Waste Management Courses

Our hazardous waste management courses are for supervisors and employees who generate, manage, handle, transport, store, treat, and/or dispose of hazardous waste and hazardous materials in California; however, these programs comply with both 22 CCR 66265.16 and 40 CFR 262.16 training requirements. Hazardous waste management course participants will receive a course manual, record of training, and certificate of completion.

Hazardous Waste Management (8-Hour) – \$299

This training meets both federal and state initial and annual refresher requirements for facility and generator personnel who generate hazardous waste as part of their job duties. Topics include fundamental practices of recordkeeping, tiered permitting, container and tank management, hazardous waste shipping (including EPA's e-Manifest system), LDRs, on-site treatment, and more.
